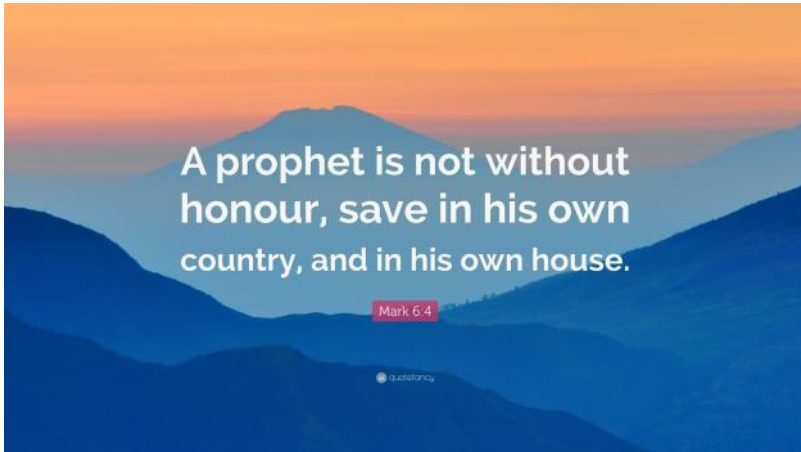

Eco Tip for this week. Meat and dairy are responsible for most greenhouse gas emissions in the agriculture industry. Emissions occur from the production stage to processing, packaging and finally delivered, Farming releases two powerful greenhouse gasses, methane from livestock digestion and nitrous oxide, an indirect product of organic and mineral nitrogen fertilisers. As most emissions result from producing and preparing meat and dairy, consuming less meat would reduce greenhouse emissions, simply reducing your intake of meat can have a big impact. Keith

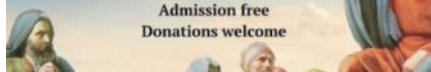
