You will have heard the news on Sunday that my role will change again from November this year.

I will remain Rector to this Parish, and will continue with my role working with deaf people in the Diocese. However, I will be giving up my Chaplaincy role at the college (half a day) and taking on being Priest in Charge of St Lukes, Moulsham (half a day).

I hope that we will continue with our positive relationship with the college and that students will still come to work in Hope cafe.

Over the years I have spent time with my colleagues Sidra (Muslim chaplain) and Alex (Buddhist chaplain). We have planned 'welcomes' and events together. We have held cake sales for charity, celebrated Religious festivals, organised costume days and taught occasional lessons linked to our different faiths. One year we had a drop in lunch time group, and some Posada dolls toured the college.

After a few years I was able to secure a Prayer/ interfaith room, which holds artefacts from all the faiths, prayers and CD's. A quiet escape. I have met many students who have experienced a bereavement and was able to offer them support, and caught up with deaf students now and again. I have worked under the umbrella of Student Support and so have many colleagues to be thankful to for their support in including us in plans and activities. Then there is Joy, who is ever creative, designing posters etc and John in the copy shop, even running a spell check. I am grateful for them all. I wish them all lots of love and God's blessing.
