

I "Love your Neighbour" an important opportunity to help

St Luke's Church has discovered that their hall roof has reinforced autoclaved aerated concrete in it (RAAC) that must be addressed for safety reasons.

They have had quotes in and need £86,200 to rectify it.

I To get the work started as soon as they can, and apply for matched grant funding, they need t raise £43,100 by October and have been making efforts to raise I this.

We wanted to help our neighbours and fellow worshippers in South West Chelmsford Churches. Our Parish funds are such that we can afford to help them, as we hope they would help us if we were faced with a similar challenge—partnership In action!

At the last PCC meting we agreed immediately to give them a donation of £5,000 from our Church funds and top this up with a loan of £5,000. In addition, we agreed to give individuals in our parish the opportunity to donate directly towards helping them pay off the loan. If you would like to help in this way you can do so anonymously by writing a cheque payable to Widford Parish PCC and sent it to me in a sealed envelope marked ""For St. Luke's roof"

This will then be allocated as a repayment of the loan and reduce the amount St Luke's need to repay to us. **Peter Wood (Widford PCC Treasurer)**
