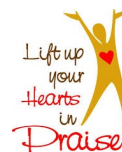

Widford Parish Tithe Payments for 2017 - part 1 (part 2 next week)

5% of all the offerings and other income received in the Parish, is given to worthy causes outside Widford. The PCC made the decision that Tithe payments would be made in the year after the year in which they are collected, with the exception of the Edapal Family.

Ali, Keshule and their children Ben, Chloe and Lydia, live in Eldoret, Kenya. Keshule has a particular ministry in Turkana, and visits that area in the North of Kenya frequently. Before moving to Africa, Ali lived in our Parish. We have supported Ali and Keshule since they were married and, because they depend on regular support – from us as well as others, we have set up a standing order, by which £250 is paid into their bank account four times each year.
